REGISTRATION FEE

A non-refundable \$100 Registration Fee per family is payable upon registration.

CONFIRMATION FEE

A non-refundable \$400 Confirmation Fee is payable upon acceptance of a place for enrolment. This is deducted from your first school fee invoice.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

Sibling Discount on Tuition Fees applies to families with more than one student attending the College offered as follows:

- Second child: 20% concession on tuition fees
- Third and subsequent children: 40% concession on tuition fees

BUILDING FUND LEVY

The Building Levy of \$160 is billed to each family per year. Money raised through this levy will only be used to support building programs and capital works programs for the benefit of students to improve facilities of the College.

AMENITIES FEE

The Amenities Fee contributes towards the College excursions and incursions, sporting and educational events, art and craft costs, and other specialised equipment as required for different learning areas.

ICT LEVY

The ICT Levy is utilised for financing and managing the necessary ICT resources for students in Year 7 to 12. This includes providing high-quality computer labs, increasing access to class iPads, and assigning personal devices to Year 11 and 12 students. The aim is to ensure that students have reliable and advanced ICT equipment readily available to enhance their learning experience.

RESOURCE FEE

The Resource Fee covers shared expenses within the classroom including student diaries and swimming lessons.





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BOOKLIST LEVY

The Booklist Levy covers stationery and reading materials issued to every Primary student. The Booklist Levy for Year 6 students includes end of year activities.

FEE SCHOLARSHIP

Each year a small number of Tuition Fee Scholarship and Rebates are available to help families under a significant financial burden to enable them to receive both a quality education and a strong spiritual foundation. The Application for Rebate form is available to apply for a College Tuition Fee Scholarship. These applications are carefully reviewed by the Principal to determine eligibility and select the appropriate recipients.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME

The State Education Department offers a Secondary Assistance Scheme for holders of Centrelink Family Health Care Card, Centrelink Pensioners Concession Card and Veterans Affairs Pensioner Concession Card. Application forms for 2024 are due in March and are available at the College Administration office.

FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

Families experiencing financial hardship during the schooling of their children may contact the Finance Manager to arrange affordable payment options during financially challenging periods.

SPLIT BILL ARRANGEMENTS

PAYMENT OPTIONS

All fees are billed at the beginning of the school year. For students enrolling part way through the year, pro rata fees will be charged at the time of enrolment. Fees are to be paid by direct debit from your nominated bank account according to the College billing procedure. All fees must be paid in full by 30 November 2024.

OPTION 1: UP FRONT PAYMENT

Full paying families receive a 5% discount on Tuition Fees when Annual Fees are fully paid by 31 March. This discount does not apply to students starting part way through the year.

OPTION 2: PAYMENT PLAN

Families have the option to pay fees by instalment payments arranged with the Finance Manager. Tuition fees and charges may be paid as follows:

- Direct Debit (preferred option) – Complete the Direct Debit Request form to authorise the Finance Office to set up a Direct Debit against your Bank Account or Credit Card.
- Electronic Funds Transfer – EFT directly to the College bank account
